George Houston Schooley, 97, of Hope, Arkansas passed away peacefully on April 27, 2024.

Mr. Schooley was born September 17, 1926 in Hope to James Earl and Alva Cole Schooley. He graduated from Hope High School and served in the United States Army Air Corps on Okinawa, Japan.
