Henry Fowler, age 89, of Morrilton, died Sunday, August 28, 2016 at the VA Medical Center in Little Rock.

He was born Oct. 8, 1926, in Hot Springs. He attended Nady Church of Nazarene in Tichnor, Ark., for many years. He was a veteran of World War II, serving in Saipan and receiving the Bronze Star for the invasion of Okinawa. After the war, he remained in Okinawa for another year of reconstruction.
