Kathryn Irene Marshall, born February 20, 1924, to John and Mary Luebke of Crocketts Bluff, Arkansas, passed away peacefully May 2, 2017.

Kathryn, one of four children, grew up in Crocketts Bluff and graduated from St. Charles High School. After graduation, she moved to Little Rock and worked at the Jacksonville Powder Plant making ammunition during World War II.

In 1946, Kathryn married Charlie B. Marshall. They lived in Ethel, farmed rice and soybeans, and raised two daughters. She and Charlie loved to take off during the day and go crappie fishing in the White River Wildlife Refuge. After her husband passed away in 1978, she welcomed two grandchildren into her life. Key in their upbringing, she continued to live and work in Ethel and then moved to Little Rock before returning to DeWitt in her final years.
