She loved to visit, no matter when, where or with whom. She was genuinely interested in getting to know you. Her spirit was like a shining star, lighting up every room she walked in. Over the years, Linda welcomed countless friends and family members into her and Jerry's home. Anyone that needed a helping hand or a comfy place to land was greeted with a big smile and hug, including many of the four-legged variety. The family would like to express their gratitude to all of Linda's caregivers at UAMS and Arkansas Hospice. But more than anything, the love and devotion of her daughter-in-law, Kim was seen and felt by all of us. Her willingness and insistence to stay with Linda at the hospital day and night the last couple of months allowed Jerry, the boys and the rest of the family to focus on just being with Linda.
